Scholarship Award

The Hurliman Scholarship Foundation will grant individual scholarship awards to senior high school students from the Colorado counties of Fremont, Custer or Pueblo. The selected students must demonstrate outstanding character and superior scholastic ability. Students may attend any accredited college or university in the United States and will not be restricted in the field of study they want to pursue.

The Hurliman Scholarship Foundation will award at least two four-year undergraduate awards that cover tuition, room and board, and a book allowance (up to \$30,000/year). One year scholarships may also be awarded. Four-year scholarship winners must complete and qualify under an annual progress report in order to continue their scholarship from year-to-year. *

* **NOTE**—DISCLOSURE TO APPLICANT: Under the terms and conditions of the Hurliman Scholarship Foundation award, the scholarship is non-transferable and is forfeited or terminated if a recipient transfers to another college or university after the scholarship has been awarded. This includes transferring to a college or school within a state university system. Therefore, applicants are advised to carefully consider their chosen college or university prior to being accepted to that school and prior to applying for the Hurliman Scholarship award.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student must be a U.S. citizen.
- Student must be a current graduating high school senior to apply.
- Student must be a resident of one of the following Colorado counties Fremont, Custer or Pueblo.
- Student must have applied to an accredited U.S. college or university as a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours per term) and must be accepted at the accredited college or university before the scholarship will be awarded.
- The four-year scholarship award is based on the following criteria:
 - Strength of Character--as evidenced by: service to school and community; letters of recommendation; personal essay; and interview.
 - Superior Scholastic Ability--based on minimum unweighted GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale and submission of SAT or ACT test result (no minimum score required).

Application Deadline

Applications must be postmarked no later than February 1, 2025 to be considered for an award.

Panel Interview

Applicants who are finalists will be interviewed in person by a panel consisting of Board members. The committee will contact the applicant to set up an interview appointment on April 5 or 6, 2025.

Notification of Winners

Winning students will be notified after April 25, 2025.
